This Indenture made and confirmed this 10th day of May one thousand eight hundred and three between Drury Parker of Newsmans being of the one part and Henry Gardner of Hampton of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Nineteen pounds to me in hand paid before the making and delivery of these presents hath granted bargained and sold unto Henry Gardner the right and title Interest and Estate which shall be my proportionable part of the estate meroce unto my wife Penelope Parker, by her father James Gardner Deceased which Estate is now in the hands of Sarah Gardner widow of said James Gardner and by me my self my heirs and assigns with warrant the said Estate and unpaired or parcel thereof against all and every other Person or persons whatsoever to the said Henry Gardner his heirs and assigns forever shall and lawfully be by these presents, In Witness whereof the said Drury Parker here put my hand and affixed my seal the 10th day of May 1803—
