 has paid and satisfied unto the said James Scott the aforesaid sum of fifty pounds
 and the interest due thereon to the date here of now know ye that I the said
 James Scott do the consideration aforesaid have and by these presents do release
 and foregoe just claim unto the said Edward Drake and to his heirs all the right
 title interest claim or demand of me the said James Scott my heirs Executors Assigns
 Agents Friends to the aforesaid parts of and property I do hereby
 acquit and discharge the said Edward Drake his heirs Executors and assigns release
