

(21) Be the same in or left, lying and being in the said County of Hampshire
 on the flat Swamp, and bounded as followeth, beginning at the corner of
 flat Swamp, at James Sunday's line. Thence down the run of said Swamp
 to a branch, thence up the branch to the fork of said branch, thence along
 a new chipped line, dividing the said Land Lots, and the said Thomas
 other lands, until it intersects the said James Sunday's line. Thence al-
 long the said Sunday's line to the Beginning. Together with all and
 singular the privileges, and advantages to the said Lands belonging in
 any manner appertaining thereto. To have and to hold the said Sunday
 his heirs of Land, and Premises, unto the said Robert Maby his heirs
 Executors Administrators and assigns forever and the said Joseph
 Harrison and Elizabeth his wife with further Covenant to and with the
 said Robert Maby his heirs and assigns that they will forever warrant
 and defend the said right and title from all person or persons claiming
