This Indenture made this 10th day of March 1804. Between John
Cagley of Southampton County of the one part and Daniel Davis of the said
County of the other part. Witnesseth that Whereas, by an indenture bearing
date 2nd of February 1802, between the said Davis of the first part and the
said John Cagley of the second part. Then was conveyed unto the said Davis
one hundred and fifty Acres of Land, Wherein he the said John
Cagley, Sally Sinkins and Johnstone Williford to the said John Cagley to
secure the payment of ninety pounds and Interest due from said Davis to the
said Cagley as by the said indenture recited, in the County of Southampton
the 15th day of October 1802 as by and before the said Davis being had witness
fully appeared, and whereas the said Cagley having received from said Davis
the full amount of the said Indenture together with the Interest accruing
thereon to the above date, and is willing to release the said Davis all the
above named property. Now This Indenture Witnesseth that
The said John Cagley as well provides in consideration of the premises as of the sum
of five shillings to him in hand paid by the said Daniel Davis at and before the
Sealing and delivery of these presents The receipt whereof the said John Cagley
doth hereby Acknowledge. That he hath granted released and given quiet Claim
and by this presents do release and quiet Claim unto the said Daniel Davis
his heirs &c. In and all the estate right title Interest Claim and demand what
soever of him the said Cagley of or to the said Daniel Davis and his
heirs and so, nor any for him shall have Claim right title Interest or
demand for recovery thereof, shall be utterly barred. In Witness whereof
