This Indenture made the 10th day of October Anno Domini 1804 between First of the one part and Ellis G. Blake of the other part both of the County of Hampton and State of Virginia, Witnesseth that whereas Henry Taylor one of the County and State aforesaid did by an Indenture bearing date 17th October 1800 make on a Mortgage unto the said Lewis First the Lessor whereof he the said Taylor was then and did possessors of for the term purposes mentioned in the aforesaid mortgage or deed of trust. Now the said Lewis First for and in Consideration of the sum of Fifty Shillings in hand to him paid by the said Blake the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and doth hereby relinquish and forever quit Claim to so much of to such part of the aforesaid Mortgage's Land as was allotted at so apart as the dividend of Ellis Gray Blake and Mary his wife as heirs of the said Henry Taylor hereby giving up all his the said Lewis First's right title and claim to the said dividend to the same more or less to him or his heirs and Administrators forever.
