This Indenture made this 15th day of April in the year of our Lord
 eighteen hundred and four Between William Pehrorth and Mary his wife of
 the one part and Old Breach of the County of Southampton of the other part
 Witnesseth that they the said William Pehrorth and Mary his wife stand
 In consideration of eighty pounds Virginia currency to them in hand paid
 by the said Old Breach before the making and delivery of these presents
 receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and themselves to be fully and
 satisfied contented and paid by the said William Pehrorth and Mary his
 wife hath bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto him the said Old Breach
 his heirs and assigns for ever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the
 County of Southampton aforesaid on the East side of a Notaway River, more
 hands gut, and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a Cypress standing
 on the side of Notaway River a corner in Elizth K. Willm's line thence along
 said Willm's line to a street from a corner in James Green's line thence
 a straight line involving on said James Green's line and Frederick's
 land to a branch near the old Ship yard, thence down the said branch
 to the rammed gut thence along the North side of the rammed gut to
 the first Station containing seventy two and an half acres more or less
 have and to hold the said land to gether with its appurtenances to him the
 said Old Breach his heirs and assigns forever and to the only lawful
 Occupancy benefit and behoof of him the said Old Breach his heirs and
 assigns, and then the said William Pehrorth and Mary his wife further
 Observe their heirs Executors and assigns as and with warrant and full
 defend the said bargain's Premises against the lawful claim and
 demand of any person whatsoever to him the said Old Breach his heirs
 and assigns forever; In Witness whereof they the said William Pehrorth
 and Mary his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day
 and date above written.
