 Marchant Gentlemen Justices Whereas William Pehrorth and Mary his wife
 have by their certain Indenture of bargain and sale dated the 15th day of
 April 1804 bearing into Obed Greasy of the County of Southampton the fol-
 lowing estate of land in a certain tract of land Situate lying and being
 in the County aforesaid containing by Estimation Seventy two and one half
 acres to the same more or less, and Whereas the said Mary cannot conveniently
 travel to the Court of our said County to acknowledge the same, therefore we
 do give to your power to receive the Acknowledgment which the said Mary
 shall be willing to make before you of the Conveyance aforesaid contained
 in the said Indenture which is hereto annexed, and we do therefore Command
 you to go personally to the said Mary's House and receive her Acknowledgment
 of the same and examine her privately and apart from her husband, whether
 she hath executed the said deed freely and Voluntarily without the threats
 or persuasion of her said husband, And whether she is willing the same should
 be recorded in the County Court of Southampton, and when you have examined her
 as aforesaid, and taken her Acknowledgment of the said Indenture that contain-
 ing and fully Certify as hereupon your hands and seals, returning to us also
 this writ. Witness the said Indenture annexed At Witness Paul Wells Clerk
 of our said Court at his Office the 10th day of April 1804 and in the 28th
