a negro woman by the name of Cleo and two Children (Peggy, Tom
Henry and Jack), also I sell unto the aforesaid Merrill and John
Merrill five head of Horses, eight head of Cattle, eight head of Sheep,
twenty five head of Hogs, five feather beds and furniture two beds
two couch rooms, five pictures, basins four dishes, twelve plates, three
Saws, three pitchforks, earthen plates, two chairs, two tables, forty two
sets of linen, eight bee gums, twelve Cedar Caskets two Hard Stairs
one top, Stacks, two bedsteads and saddles, twelve Sets of leather, one gun
one clock and wheels, one Stove, thirty bushels of Potatoes one hundred
weight of cotton two Spinning Wheels, one glass case
a pair of Axes, four axes, four plow bars, one cross cut saw, one saw
