 of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said Henry Brantley
 and Matthew his wife for and in Consideration of the
 sum of the sum of two hundred and Sixty Seven Dollars
 Current money to them in hand paid by the said Joseph
 Bracey the receipt whereof by the said Henry Brantley
 and Matthew his wife with hereby Acknowledged, the said
 Henry Brantley hath granted bargained and sold and
 confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain &
 sell, alien and confirm unto the said Joseph Bracey his
 heirs and assigns, one certain tract or parcel, lying and
 being in the County aforesaid, Beginning at a line then
 standing at the corner of Jesse Williams line then
 by a line of marked trees to a pine standing in them
 of Flag branch, thence down the run of said branch
 to a run in angle, thence up said branch to a large
