 - the his, and Thomas Davis containing in the whole three
 tracts two hundred and twelve acres be the same more or less
 lying on the north side of the road, and bounded as specified and shown
 - be in the deed from the several persons before named to the
 said Francis and Sally reference thereto be made unto they appear
 to have an old hold the said tract of land to gather with the
 appurtenances to them the said Robt. Rich and his heirs and the
 Francis Hill and Sally his wife then and each of them their
 Executors and Administrators the said tract or parcel of land
 with their appurtenances to him the said Robt. Rich his
 heirs and assigns shall and lawfully forever remain to him
 and his heirs whereof the said Francis and Sally have hereunto
 set their hands and seals on the day and Year above written
