This Indenture made the 13th day of Dec^r
 in the year of our Lord Christ 180 Between Mills
 Griffin of the County of Southampton of the one part and
 Jacob Turner of the same parish and County of a said
 Witnesses that the said Mills Griffin for and in
 consideration of the sum of two hundred and three pounds
 Lawful money of Virginia, to him in hand paid by the said
 Jacob Turner, the receipt whereof the said Mills Griffin doth
 acknowledge himself Sufficiently Satisfied Contented and
 paid and doth grant bargain and have sole Abundant
 confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain, sell
 and confirm unto the said Jacob Turner his heirs & assigns
 a certain tract or parcel of Land and premises, lying and being
 in the aforesaid parish and County, on the North side of
 a Creek containing, by Estimation two hundred and three Acres &
 the same more or less and bounded as followeth. Beginning
 at a Right angle post a corner of Bigg Carstaphum line then
 a straight line of marks trees by the Carstaphum line to
 have a corner of David Carstaphum line then a straight
 line of marks trees to said Carstaphum line to a line of marks
 have a corner of said Carstaphum line, and a straight line, &c.
