deals and Sally Meale. I do give grant and make over to them ~~they~~ said  
Granddaughters Patience Meale Jeany Meale and to their heirs forever the  
sole and property I give unto my Grand Daughter Patience Meale  
all the land all the land I own except fifty Acres to go with one my  
Gives Deeds to her and her heirs forever - the land lying on both sides  
of the South Carolina Swamp and being the plantation where I now  
live and bound by the Ancient and known line of the said land containing  
one hundred and fifty Acres be she some more or less - I give unto my  
Grand daughter Jeany Meale the above mentioned fifty  
Acres more or less adjoining the fish road where I had a house  
long house to go with one my girl Sell the to her and her  
heirs forever - I give unto my Grand daughter Sally Meale  
my son named Sam and Hanna to her and her heirs forever - and by  
these presents I do give and fully give the above said land  
premises unto my said Grand daughter Patience Meale Jeany  
Meale and Sally Meale and to their heirs & assigns forever
