This Indenture made this 10th day of July in the year of our Lord
1804. Between Frederick Boykin of the County of Southampton and State
of Virginia of the first part and Lazarus Cook of said County and State
of the second part, and Charles Bidsong of said County and State of the
third part, Whereas the said Frederick Boykin is Justly indebted to the
said Lazarus Cook the full sum of two hundred and thirty three Pounds
one Shilling Virginia Currency bearing even date with these presents, and
the said Boykin being willing and desirous to secure the said Lazarus
Cook the payment thereof together with the legal Interest accruing
and to be due of charging, Rescinding and Carrying into effect this present
Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Frederick Boykin in con-
sideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Charles
Bidsong, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained
and sold and by these presents with bargain and sale unto the said Charles
Bidsong his heirs and assigns forever the following property to wit
one negro man by the name of Isaac, one negro woman by the name
of Mary one negro girl by the name of Phillis, one negro boy by the
name of Phileas also two bay horses, fifteen head of Cattle, eight head of
Sheep, forty head of hogs, four feathered fowls and furniture. Also all my
household and kitchen of all kinds, To have and to hold the above
said Property unto him the said Charles Bidsong his heirs and assigns
to the only purpose use and behoof of the said Charles Bidsong his heirs
and assigns forever, and the said Frederick Boykin for him self his heirs
