This Indenture made this 15th day of Dec in the year
of our Lord Christ 1800 Between Mills Griffin of the County of
Sampson of the one part and Said Paine of the same parish and
County of the other part Witness that the said Mills Griffin for and
in consideration of the sum of two hundred and three pounds
Mony of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Said Paine
the receipt whereof the said Mills Griffin doth acknowledge himself
sufficiently Satisfied Contented and paid and doth grant bargain and
sell Assign and Confirm and by these presents doth grant bargain
sell Assign and Confirm unto the said Said Paine his heirs and assigns
A Certain tract or parcel of land and Premises lying and being in the parish
and County on the North side of Black Creek containing by Estimation
two hundred and three acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows
to wit Beginning at a Lightwood post a corner of Piggys Land then
line, thence a straight line of marked trees by the said Constable
line, thence across of Davis Constables line to again in the long
branch across of said Constables line, and a straight line of
Beeches thence up said branch to again join across of the Constables
line, thence a line of marked trees by said Constables of Henry Griffins
line to the first station with all houses out houses edifices
yards gardens orchards ways water and water courses for profit
