This Indenture, made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of October in the Year of our  
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and four, between Matthew Weston and  
 Benjamin Weston of Lancaster County of the one part and E. Chittenden,  
 William of the said County of the other part. Witnesseth that the  
 Matthew and Benjamin Weston of and in Commission of the sum of  
 one hundred and eighty dollars to them in hand paid by the said E.  
 Chittenden the receipt. Whereof is hereby Acknowledged by the said Matthew  
 and Benjamin Weston have granted bargained and Sold Alundrop  
 and Confirmed unto the said E. Chittenden, William, his heirs and Assigns forever,  
 One certain tract or parcel of land containing by Estimation thirty Six acres  
 be the same more or less, Situate lying and being in the County of Lancaster  
 more or less that Lears from Jerusalem to black water, and bounded as  
 follows (Viz) Beginning at a post on the side of the road thence along  
 a new line of Thomas Camps N 32 W 98 pole to the old line to  
 and Oak along the old line S. 70<sup>th</sup> W 90 pole to lightwood Stake  
 again thence S 62<sup>th</sup> E 136<sup>th</sup> pole to a pine on the side of the road and  
 down the said road to the Beginning. To have and to hold these  
 lands and premises and every part and parcel and also the reversion and  
 reversion remainder and remaining Right and title Interest Claim and  
 Demand whatsoever of them the said person or persons Claiming under them  
 in case to the said premises all and Singular the said Lands and  
 Premises unto the said E. Chittenden, William for him self his heirs  
 and assigns of land and every part hereof Against themselves and their heirs  
 and Against all and every person or persons to the said E. Chittenden, William  
 his heirs and Assigns Share and Will Warrant and for ever defied by them  
 pursuant In witness whereof the said Matthew and Benjamin Weston  
 have hereunto set their hands and Seal this 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1804.
