This Indenture made this fifteenth day of October Anno Domini
1814 Between Robert Goddard Thomas, Nathl James Nathan
John Taylor and Edwin Gray Gentlemen Trustees as appointed
by Act of Assembly of Virginia bearing date December 1791.
Jeremiah Lott Domini 1791. for the purpose of laying
off a Town by the name of Jerusalem, on the Land of
Joseph and William Scott, adjoining the Centhouse of
Sampson, on the one part; and Joshua Fort of the other
Witnesseth that the said Trustees as aforesaid for and in
consideration of five pounds current money of Virginia to
be paid by the said Joshua Fort pursuant to the Act
Act to the aforesaid Joseph and William Scott, do bargain
sell alien and confirm unto the said J Fort and his heirs
forever, one Lot or parcel of Land lying in the town of
Jerusalem Numbered Seven and bounded as follows Viz
beginning on the West Side of the main Street and bounded by
the South side of the Crp Street, two hundred and thirty
Seven feet nine inches to the North east Corner of Main
(Lot) thence along Lot No. nine, ninety feet from South
to the North West Corner of Lot No. eight thence along the
Side Lot No. eight two hundred and thirty seven feet nine
inches to the main Street, ninety feet from South to the beginning
I have said to hope the said Lot or parcel of Land with
the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said J Fort &
his heirs forever, and the said J Fort doth acknowledge &
agree in the manner and form following (Witnesseth)
that he the said J Fort or his heirs, Shave and his heirs
on the Lot No. Seven a dwelling house sixteen feet long
