The Commencement of Virginia to Richard Clements and Frederick Parker Sentences of the peace for the County of Southampton granting Whereas John Hey and Nancy his wife have by their Certain indenture of bargain and Sale dated the 14 day of February 1805 conveyed unto John Prince of the County of Surfer the fee Simple Estate of and in 83 1/3 Acres of land more or less that Whereas the said Nancy Hey cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our said County to acknowledge the same Whence We do give to you power to receive the Acknowledgments of the said Nancy Shall be willing to make before you of the foregoing aforesaid Contents in the said Indenture which is here Annexed and We do therefore Command you to go personally to the said Nancy and receive her Acknowledgments of the same and examine her private and apart from her husband Whether She hath executed the said Deed truly & Voluntarily without the pressure or threats of the said her husband and whether She is willing the same should be recorded in the County Court of Southampton and when you have given her aforesaid and taken her Acknowledgments of the said Indenture that you do certify and openly certify in heretofore and your hearing and do hereby returning to me all the said with the said Indenture Annexed Witness I John Hey Clerk of our said Court at his office this 14th day of February 1805 and in the 29th Year of the Commencement
