This Indenture made this 28th day of January in the
 of our Lord 1805 Between John Williams and Rebecca his
 wife of the Parish of Wottonay and County of Southampton of
 the one part, and Michael Ellis of the aforesaid Parish and
 County of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Williams
 and Rebecca his wife for and in Consideration of the Sum of
 full sum of twenty two pounds thirteen Shilling Current money
 of England to them in hand paid by the said Michael Ellis
 before the making and Dating of these presents the receipt whereof
 they the said John Williams and Rebecca his wife doth hereby
 acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Michael
 Ellis his him and assigns forever. Be the said John Williams
 and Rebecca his wife hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed
 released delivered and Conferred and by these presents doth
 grant bargain sold alien enfeoff release deliver and Conferred
 unto the said Michael Ellis his him and assigns forever, all that
 plantation tract and parcel of Land which fell to the said
 Rebecca Williams by the Death of her brother William
 Jones (Deceased) containing fifty and one third Acre lying and
 being in the parish and County aforesaid and bounded as follows
 (To wit) Beginning at corner White Oak in Rudge line thence S 88
 88 1/2 deg to corner White Oak in Rudge line thence S 50 W 12 1/2
 deg to corner pine tree along said Rudge line N 88 W 54
 deg to an old Miller Oak thence N 21 East anew line to
 the Beginning, and all the houses out houses offices buildings
 walls ways, water, and Water Course profits Emendments here
 and there and Appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging
 or in any wise Appurtenancing and the revenues and incomes
 and annuities and a manner what profits and profits thereof which
 to the same belonging or in any wise Appurtenancing and all the
 right title Interest Claim and Demand of him the said John
 Williams
