of the Sum and full sum of eight hundred Dollars Current
Money of Virginia by the said James Scott to him in hand
paid, the receipt whereof the said William Washington doth hereby
Acknowledge and thereof August and in charge the said James
Scott his heirs and assigns and lawfully therewith fully and entirely
Satisfied Contented and paid to the said William Washington with
grants bargains, sole aliened, enfeoffed and released themselves
& Confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell
Alien enfeoff Release deliver & Confirm unto the
said James Scott and to his heirs and assigns forever all their
Plantations messuages, tenements or parcels of land which George
Washington did give by his Last will and testament to
his son the aforesaid William Washington Also all the
Plantations messuages, tenements and parcels of Land which
