This Indenture made this 1st day of June in the year of our Lord Christ 1804 ~~1800~~ in the 28th year of the independence of the United States of America Between Charles Barham Men of the State of Georgia and Columbus County of the one part and John Barlow of the State of Virginia and Sampson County of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him ~~Barham~~ Charles Barham in hand paid by the said John Barlow at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Charles Barham hath granted bargained, sold, aliened, Enfeoffed, Conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain, sell, alien Enfeoff, Convey and Confirm unto the said John Barlow his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract piece or parcel of land containing forty acres (be it more or less) Situate lying and being in the State of Virginia in Sampson or a branch of the Raccoon Swamp known by the name of Sam Swamps bettering and bounding by the Lands of Nathaniel Barham and William as Capes being my lot of divided of the one side of my father John Barham as to the Covenants and Distances more fully Apppear, Together with all and singlular the Appurtenances and hereditaments thereto belonging and all the estate right title, Interest Property Possession Claim and Demand whatsoever of him the Charles Barham and also remission of recovery remainder and remainders - To have and to hold
