 fifteen pounds current money of Virginia by the said Robt. Williams
 to him in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents
 the receipt whereof the said John Underwood, with his duly acknowledged
 and thereof August and discharge the said Robt. Williams his heirs
 Executors administrators and assigns forever by these presents the said
 John Underwood hath granted bargained sold aliened released
 set over and delivered and confirmed and by these presents doth grant
 bargain sell alien release set over deliver and confirm unto the said
 Robt. Williams and to his heirs forever, as should tract or parcel
 of Land situate lying and being in the County of Hampton
 and parish of St. Luke aforesaid, containing by Estimation fifteen
 Acres both more or less (hereinafter as follows to wit) Beginning
 at a pine at the Corner of the old field and running S. 55° E. 52 ft
 to a Oak across of Thomas Edwards Robt. Williams and said said
 thence N. 45° E. 60 ft thence N. 55° E. 53 ft to a black Gum Tree
 N. 57° E. 76 ft to a pine in the old field thence S. 57° E. 11 ft
 to the Beginning also also having our Surveyors Surveyors

 and Appurtenances Whatsoever the said belonging in anywise
