

This Indenture made this 15th day of January 1805

Between William Laurence and Willey Laurence his wife of the County of Sampson and Parish of Netterway of the one part and Mary Johnson of the County and Parish aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said William Laurence and Willey Laurence his wife for and in Consideration of the Sum of one hundred two pounds Current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Mary Johnson themselves entirely Satisfied Contented and so Well granted, bargained, Sold, aliened, enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents do grant, bargained, Sell, alien, enfeoffed and Confirm unto the said Mary Johnson her heirs and assigns certain tract and parcel of Land lying and being in the County and Parish aforesaid Containing by Estimation one hundred and ten Acres, be the same more or less bounded as follow, (to-wit) Beginning at a black Gum in John Southwells line, thence to a small gum in said Southwells line, thence to a pine across two of John Johnsons line? thence thro' the Pocon along Daniel Simmonds line to the middle of the thoroughfare branch, thence down said branch to the Willow Oak in Elias Coblens and John Johnsons line? thence up the Bog-pen branch to the first Station. With all houses and houses Outbuildings, Gardens, Orchards, Water, and Water Courses, profits and Appurtenances, thereto belonging, or in any wise Appurtenanting thereto, Together with all rights Claims or demands Whatsoever of the said William Laurence and Willey Laurence his wife and to the same or any part thereof and all Dues or Rents due touching or in any wise Concerning the same To have and to hold the said bargained premises forever and the said Willey Laurence and Willey his wife for themselves their heirs and assigns forever Certain premises and Agreed to and with the said Mary Johnson her heirs and assigns forever, and by these presents do further warrant and defend unto the said Mary Johnson her heirs and assigns all rights titles Claims or demands of any persons or persons Whatsoever against the said tract and parcel of Land I Well stuff.
