 their heirs fully and entirely satisfied Contented and paid the said for
 Drake and Nathaniel Drake have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoff
 released delivered and Confirmed and by these do grant bargain
 sell alien enfeoff release deliver and Confirm unto the said
 Drake and to his heirs and assigns forever a certain part of the
 Plantation or Marriage tract and parcel of Land whereon the said
 John Drake now lives situate lying and being in the County of
