 of the sum of Eighty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said
 Jeremiah Johnson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 that the said Jeremiah Johnson grants, bargains, sells, Confirms, and conveys over and by
 these presents, with give, grant, bargain, sells, Confirms and conveys
 over unto the said Jeremiah Johnson his heirs and assigns forever,
 One Certain tract or parcel of land, Situate lying and being in the
 County of Sampson aforesaid, and Bounded as follows, Beginning
 at a red oak standing in the deep branch, thence a north course
 along Cole Runners Ridley line to a white Oak standing in South
 Drows line, across the thence along said Drows line a north
 West course to a white Oak standing in Harris Johnson line a course
 thence a south course along Harris Johnson line to the beginning
 thence an east course along said Harris Johnson line to the beginning
 containing by Estimation fifty Acres or the same more or less, To
 have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all the
