three hundred dollars, good and lawful Money of Virginia to them in hand
paid by the said Saml Turner the receipt whereof they do hereby
acknowledge themselves fully and completely satisfied and paid, have granted
sold bargained and sold unto by their present doct of grant and bargain
and sell unto the said Saml Turner his heirs and assigns forever, a certain
tract, plantation, or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid
County containing by estimation ^{more or less} to the same more or
less and bounded as follows, Beginning at a black oak acorn tree at
John Bygones line, thence to a red Oak acorn tree in John Turners
and Ephraim Turners line, thence along along a line of marked trees to
