of St. Lukes Containing by Estimation Sixty two Acres and some thing
less than same, more or less, and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning
at a branch spring in Mary Pops line a Corner between Nathan Williams

wood stump a corner of said William thence along said Williams line
to a Hickory a half Acre in said Williams line, thence along said
Williams line to a gum Oak in Corner in Williams line to the
