This Indenture made this 17th day of January in the year
of our Lord 1805 Between Hosea Norton and Crispy his wife and
Septimion Blake and Manry his wife each of Sampson County and State
of Virginia of the one part and Henry Smith of said County and State
of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Hosea Norton
Crispy his wife and Septimion Blake and Manry his wife for and in
Commencement of the sum of five hundred dollars in hand paid by the said Henry
Smith to the said Hosea Norton and Crispy his wife and Septimion
Blake and Manry his wife before the making and signing of these
present the receipt whereof the said Hosea Norton and Crispy his wife
and Septimion Blake and Manry his wife doth hereby fully acknow-
ledge hath granted bargain sold Enfeoffed and Confirmed and by
these presents for themselves and their heirs doth clearly and absolutely
grant bargain sell Enfeoff and Confirm unto the said Henry Smith
his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land situate
lying and being in the County of Sampson and State aforesaid sit-
uate being the land formerly held by James Catheys and by him
conveyed to Mary Blake and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning
at the corner of the flat swamp in Mrs Blounts Meads at the corner
where the same runs along said Mountain line to Joel McEmers line
thence along said McEmers line to Grankers branch thence down the
said branch to William Blounts line thence along said Blounts line to the
Mill pond thence to the run of the said swamp thence up the said swamp
to the beginning. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel
of land containing by Estimation five hundred and sixty acres more
or less with the appurtenances unto the said Henry Smith his heirs
and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Henry
Smith his heirs and assigns forever and the said Hosea Norton and
Crispy his wife and Septimion Blake and Manry his wife forth-
with and then him as Covenant and grant to and with the said
