This Indenture made the 10th day of May 1805. Between
Thomas Mooton and Mary his Wife of the County of St. James
part and Henry Lewis of the same County of the other part Witnesses these
be the said Thomas Mooton and Mary his Wife for and in consideration of the sum
and full sum of Fifty two dollars to them in hand paid by the said Henry
Lewis at or before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof
being acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents, one
each of them do, bargain and sell unto the said Henry Lewis his heirs &
Assigns. A certain tract of land containing some six or the same more or less
and bounded as follows. (To wit) Beginning on the east side of round
Hill road in Westmore Millers, then thence East along the said Round Hill
to a well oak a corner tree, thence West to a Red Oak at the same corner tree
road, thence the said road to the Beginning; Also 10 feet square into
West side of the said round Hill Road opposite to the above recited tract.
To have and to hold the said lands with the tenements hereunto
and all and singular other the premises therunto belonging and every part and
parcel thereof, with every of their rights, tenements and appurtenances unto the said Henry
Lynn his heirs and assigns forever to have, for the only proper use and behoof
of him the said Henry Lewis his heirs and assigns forever, and the said
Mooton and Mary his Wife for themselves and their heirs the said plantation with
all and singular the premises and appurtenances unto the said Henry Lewis his
heirs and assigns, free from the claim or claim of them the said Thomas Mooton
and Mary his Wife, or either of them, their or either of their heirs, and also of
any other person or persons whatsoever, shall be in and do to answer and for in
Defense, by these presents. In Witness whereof the said Thomas Mooton
