Know all men by these presents that I Willel R Holladay of Sampson County
 indebted to Henry Barrow of the same County the just sum of two hundred and
 seventy two pounds eight Shillings current money of Virginia and being willing
 and Desiring to secure the payment thereof have as well for the Consideration
 of the said Henry Barrow the sum of two hundred and seventy two pounds eight Shillings
 as also one dollar to me in hand paid by Humphrey Drury of the same
 County as Trustee for the said Henry Barrow, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged. I the said Willel R Holladay have granted bargained
 and Sold and by these presents do grant bargain and Sell unto the
 Humphrey the following property to wit one tract or parcel of Land
 lying in the said County and Parish of St. Luke and bounded as follow
 Beginning at a maple a corner tree in Thomas Parmenter and Henry Bar
 row thence along the said Henry line to a pine in Thomas Highhugh's line
 thence along the said Highhugh's line to a pine across the South side of the
 new road, thence up the new road to a post. Thence along above said
 line to an oak in Ross Swamp, thence along the Virginia County side
 Swamp to a maple across the line in Henry Bettles line, thence along the said
 Bettles line to form a corner tree, in Henry Barrow's line, thence along the
 Henry Barrow's line to the Beginning. Contain two hundred and seventy
 four acres or less, and one negro Boatswain, one negro man named David
 one free blacker boys, and furniture to be have and to hold the above property
 unto the said Humphrey Drury his heirs executors and assigns in special trust and
 confidence to the intent and purpose that if the aforesaid sum of two hundred
 and seventy two pounds eight Shillings shall remain unpaid to the said Henry
 Barrow his executors administrators or assigns at or before the first day of May
 next that then the said Humphrey Drury his heirs executors and assigns
 shall after giving reasonable notice enforce the aforesaid Property to pay
 the same at any time after the first day of June next ensuing and shall
 the money arising therefrom first to pay and satisfy the aforesaid sum of two hundred
 and seventy two pounds eight Shillings with Interest and Costs also the exp
 attending the execution of this trust and the surplus (if any) to return to
 the said Willel R Holladay my heirs executors and assigns = =
