This Indenture made the 20th day of May in the year of
 our Lord 1805 Between Thomas Fier and Benjamin Fier his wife
 of the one part and William, Clerk of the other part; all of the County of
 Southampton, Weymouthshire the said Thomas Fier and wife for and
 in consideration of the sum of forty one pounds, seven shillings
 bearing many of Virginia hath granted and by their present act grant
 and confirm given, unto the said William, Clerk his heirs assigns a certain
 tract or piece of Land by Estimation containing thirty one and one
 or less and bounded as followeth, Beginning at a point across the
 between said Land and Tabitha Vicks land thence along along a line
 being North 3/4 East to a white Oak near the edge of the
 Longwood of Mottosay River joining the adjacent William Vicks
 land thence across the Caprice Creek of the meadow of Mottosay River
 to a point along between the adjoining of John Riches and the adjacent
 Vicks land thence along the line of the adjacent and adjoining North 83
 West 8/10 to the Beginning, it being part of the tract Sherrard
 Vicks was seized and possessed with being together to the said Fier's wife
 with house out house, Garden, Orchard, many woods and Waterways
 woods and underwoods, mines and minerals, and all profits and emoluments
 tithes thereto belonging and in any other appurtenances to have
 and to hold the said premises with the appurtenances unto the
 said William, Clerk his heirs and assigns for ever - - - - -
