This Indenture made the 25th day of June 1805

Between Wm. Wadsworth and Eliza his wife of the County of St.ampton of the
one part and Robert Parks of the same County of the other part.

Witnesseth that the said Wm. Wadsworth and Eliza his wife
for and in consideration of the sum of twelve hundred Dollars, to them in
hand paid by the said Robert Parks the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by their powers
do grant bargain, sell, alien, release, and confirmed unto the said Robert
Parks his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying
being in County of St.ampton aforesaid and Parish of Newbury
formerly called the Midway Glebe containing by estimation two hundred
and thirty three & the same more or less which said tract of Land was
purchased by the said Wm. Wadsworth of the overseers of the poor under
Act of the General Assembly authorizing the sale of the Glebe land
in the State of Virginia which Deed hath been duly recorded
records, in the Court of the County of St.ampton aforesaid, reference
being had to the record thereof the same well fully appear &
Which said tract of Land is bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning
at a Gum on the South West Side of a main branch of the Spunkies Swamp
then S. 50° W. 1/2 pole to a black Oak, then N. W. 1/2 pole to a red Oak
then North by E. 1/2 pole to a main Hickory then North 37° East 1/2
pole to another Oak on the further side of the branch begun upon the
North 67° 8' 12' 8' pole to an hick Oak then S. 7° E. 28' pole to a
Oak and Hickory, then S. 58° W. 1/2 pole to a red Oak then
S. 77° W. 1/2 pole to a Hickory then S. 51° W. 1/2 pole to a Gum
on the run of the branch begun on and down the various corners
the run of the said branch to the Beginning = To have and to hold
the said tract and parcel of Land together with its appurtenances
unto the said Robert Parks his heirs and assigns to the only proper
use of him the said Robert Parks his heirs and assigns forever and the
said Wm. Wadsworth for himself, his heirs, executors and administrators
