This Indenture made this 26th day of December
 the year of our Lord 1804 and in the Year of the Commencement hereof
 John Wadsworth and Mary his wife of St. James County of the one part,
 and Nicholas Poston of the same County of the other part, Witnesseth
 that the said John Wadsworth and Mary his wife for and in consideration
 of the sum of one hundred pounds of lawful money of the Commonwealth
 to them in hand paid by the said Nicholas Poston also before the making
 and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged)
 have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver
 unto the said Nicholas Poston his heirs and assigns a Certain tract or
 parcel of land (that William Wadsworth - son of William Wadsworth
 and wife) lying and being in the County above mentioned and parish
 of St. James and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at white Oak in the
 line between said land and John Wadsworth, then in the strong trunked
 the road, thence along along of meadows to Black Creek, down ~~the~~ ^{the} ~~road~~ ^{road}
 to the mouth of the Burn branch, thence up the said branch to the
 of marked tree, thence along the line of marked tree to the road
 then along the said road to the free Station. Together with all the things
 there done hereto, to have and to hold unto the said Nicholas Poston, his heirs and assigns forever.
