This Indenture made this 13th day of July 1805 between Charles Binsong and Sally his wife of the County of Hampshire of the one part and Drury Bryant of the aforesaid County of the other, parties of the first part the said Charles Binsong and wife for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar to him in hand paid by the said Drury Bryant the receipt whereof the said Charles Binsong and wife have granted bargain and sold aliened conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien, convey and confirm unto the said Drury Bryant his heirs and assigns forever the certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Hampshire aforesaid and in the parish of St. Luke's containing by estimation one hundred and twenty five Acres in there the same more or less and bounded as follows, To wit Beginning at the mouth of a brook in the said township, thence by the said brook to a black Birch a Corner in Perry's land, thence by a line to a Corner in Perry's land, thence along the said Perry's line to a Corner in the said Perry's land, thence along the said Perry's line to the north west corner to Street Green corner in Perry's land, thence down the run of said brook to a Corner in
