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This Indenture made the eight day of October Anno Domini 1705

Between the elements of the country, by a compass of the one part and land
 books of the said County of the other part. Witnesseth that whereas, in
 to one undivided part or portion (Vizt the sixth) of a tract of land
 lying on the borders of Primmish, hath accorde to the said Francis
 by inheritance from his father Ely abett, which said tract of land was
 Divided by Benjamin Blount, Father of the said Francis and Sarah
 his daughter, and Ely abett, and is borne as follows (Vizt) Beginning
 at white oak, at the Creek, a Corner ten of said formerly the property of Henry
 Harrison De: then by the said Francis, late Son of said Henry De: 1794
 to whiting, thence North West by said one hundred and twenty two feet to
 white oak, thence North 80° West, eight feet to another oak, thence S. W. and
 by S. 25° E. feet to another oak thence S. 60° East 3. 1/2 feet to another oak, thence S 25°
 E 80 feet to another oak, at the Creek aforesaid, thence up the meanders of the
 said Creek to the beginning, Now the said Francis, deceased, in Consideration of the
 Love and affection which he bore to his sister, the said Sarah, and for a
 Consideration of the sum of one thousand pounds to him in hand paid by the said
 Sarah (the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and hath given her bargain
 and sold, assign and confirm, and by their presents doth bargain and sell
 assign, and confirm to the said Sarah her heirs and assigns forever, all
 his said part or portion of the said tract of land above mentioned
 together with all rights and appurtenances to his said part or portion
 of the said tract of land belonging now or hereafter, and
 also all the entire right, title Interest and Claim, whosoever, of him the said
 Francis, is and to the said tract of land and also and every part and parcel
 thereof To have and to hold the said enclosed part and portion
 of the said land and also and singular the premises above mentioned with the
 appurtenances, unto the said Sarah and to the only persons and heirs of the
 said Sarah her heirs and assigns forever and the said Francis, for himself and
 his heirs the said enclosed part and portion of the said land and every part
 thereof against himself and his heirs, shall and vice versa, and shall
 defend by due process = Should term my whole life parties to due process, shall
 himself and heirs and assigns, our dears the Day and Year above written
