This Indenture made this 17th day of Sept. 1804 Between
 Gray, Thomas Ridley, Robert Grosvenor, James Withers, and John Taylor
 Gentlemen Trustees on the one part, and Samuel Curren of
 the County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth, that whereas an act of the
 General Assembly of Virginia, passed December 7th 1791 entitled an act to
 establish certain town and other purposes, hath enacted that ten acres of land
 adjoining the Court house in the County of Southampton the property of Joseph
 William Curren should be and may thereby Vest in certain Gray, James Withers
 &c. Samuel Curren, Benjamin Blount, Thomas Ridley Benjamin Bluff
 Robert Grosvenor and John Taylor Gentlemen Trustees by whom was
 Majority of them, laid off into Lots, of an half Acre each, with certain
 streets and situated upon by the name of Surveyors, and whereas the said act hath
 fully directed the said Trustees or any of them should proceed to sell the
 said Lots with public Auction for the best price that could be had for the same
 and hath empowered the said Trustees to convey the same to the purchasers
 thereof or to a certain Certificate, which may be more particularly known
 by a reference to the said Act - Now this Indenture Witnesseth
 that the said Curren Gray, Thomas Ridley, Robert Grosvenor, James Withers
 and John Taylor Gentlemen Trustees as aforesaid, for and in consideration
 of the sum of twenty thousand pounds current money of Virginia, paid to the
 said and William Curren pursuant to the aforesaid Act - have bargained and
 aliened and conveyed, and by their presents do bargain, sell, alien and convey unto
 the said Samuel Curren, to him and his heirs forever the Lots or parcels of land
 lying in the said town of Surveyors, distinguished by the plan of the
 town by Numbers 5, 6, and 7, and bounded as follows (to wit) The S. E. Beginning
 at the S. Corner of No. 1 with West side of the main street thence along the
 main street of 60 feet to the Corp. street thence along the Corp.
 street 237 feet of which to the Corner of No. 6, with the S. E. Corner of No. 6
 91 feet to the Corner of No. 1 thence running on No. 1 230 feet of which to the
 beginning the other lot No. 6 beginning at the S. W. Corner of No. 1 with the
 side of the Corp. street thence along the said Street 132 feet to the
 thence up the side to the S. E. Corner of No. 1 thence along the
