Articles of Agreement made and entered into this 26th day of October

 and in conformity of the Contract and agreement of the part of the said Israel
 Vick hereinafter mentioned (Viz) that he the said Israel Vick for himself
 and his heirs assigns and assigns by the then present and here
 hereinafter to be made the said Sam^l Calvert and his heirs assigns all the whole
 Right Title Interest Claim and Demand of him the said Israel Vick of his heirs
 or assigns in and to the certain Lots or half acre each of Lots, situated in the said
 town of Jerusalem and distinguished by the plan of the said Town, by the
 Number 10 and 11 in the N^o 5 & 6 Ward in or near that the said Sam^l Calvert
 and his heirs may Obtain and get legal right and title thereto the said Israel
 Vick for him self and his heirs assigns hereby agrees that the Commissioners of the
 said town of Jerusalem or majority of them shall and may at any time at
 the will and pleasure of the said Sam^l Calvert or his heirs assigns and may
 use the said Sam^l Calvert or his heirs assigns and or Deeds of Conveyance
 so subject to the said Sam^l Calvert or his heirs assigns meet the Conditions
 of improving the said Lot not to agreeable to the original intent of the
 Lots of the said Town (the said Lot no 3 having been truly improved by
