of delivery of these presents I have given and granted and by these presents do give &
and grant unto the said Matthew Turner his Executors adm't & Assigns One tract of land
containing one hundred and fifty acres situated in the County of Southampton and state of Virg-
inia, five improved namely Calverton, Calverton, Arthur, Somers and Kellars also my part of Ligonier
Oliver, Yella, Tattnall and Lawrence at the deal of my Mother. ^{TO HABEAT 100 ACRES}
The said property unto him the said Matthew Turner his Executors adm't &
Assigns forever and the said Waller Turner for himself his heirs and assigns the said
property unto the said Matthew Turner his Executors adm't & Assigns against the
claim of him the said Waller Turner his heirs and assigns and against the
claim or claim of all other person or persons whatever shall & will warrant

This Indenture made this 10th day of December one thousand eight hundred
and sixties between Matthew 13, a minor, with the inhabitants of John Sheland his of the
County of Southampton of the one part and Ilesas Holloman of the said County of the
part first, that the said Matthew 13, doth acknowledge the acknowledgment of John Sheland
and doth for and in consideration of the sum of £100 to be paid me in Shilling current
money of Virginia to him in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivering of these
presents she excepted of the said Matthew 13, doth acknowledge with the inhabitants of
John Sheland, doth fully acknowledge himself fully satisfied Contended and being
that granted bargains sold alienated supplied and delivered and by these presents doth
grant bargain sell alienate supply and deliver unto the said Elias Holloman and doth
have an assigned former abode tract of land and premises with the appurtenances
thereof lying and being in the County of Southampton which doth by virtue of the last
will and testament of the said John Sheland doth contain by estimation about one
hundred and twenty acres as follows beginning at a corner of land Sheland's
said afft of John Sheland Holloman then along a line of marked trees to a fence under
the Convection of said Sheland and first afft of said Sheland running along a line of
marked trees to another from a corner of land Sheland and a going thence
Shelington lane due south along a line of marked trees to another piece of land
near the road or corner of John Sheland and thereon a tract of land
and road to the beginning also all woods underwood comprest to a fence under
the same for the common uses and advantages whatsoever he or she
desireth to have or any other uses affording him or her convenience.
