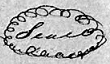

This Indenture made this 20th day of Aug^r
1805 Between William Gray and Lynns his wife of the one part
and William Whitchurch of the other part, both of the County
of Southampton = Witnesseth that the said William Gray & his
Wife for and in consideration of the sum of thirty three pounds,
seven Shillings & eight pence of Value, to him in hand
paid by the said William Whitchurch, at or upon the making
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof they do hereby
acknowledge have granted bargain sold delivered & conveyed
Confirmed and made over, and do by these presents for themselves
their heirs executors and administrators, grant bargain sell & convey
infeoff Confirm and make over unto the said William Whitchurch
his heirs &c. Powers all their right title Claim and demand that has
been conveyed to him in a Deed from Benjamin Gray recorded in
Sampson's Court, Thirty acres of that tract or parcel of land
which the said Benjamin Gray purchased of Jesse Atkinson Situate
and being in the County of Southampton on the East side of Blunsdon
containing thirty acres by & unto Saml^l the same more or less
and bounded as follows (viz) Beginning at a well or corner of
William Norton ~~land~~ ^{land} situated and said Land and
running North 36° 38' 40" E to a stone stump, thence North 38°
W. 86 paces to a stone or corner of William Whitchurch and said Land
