

At a court held for the County of Southampton the 16th day of Aug^r 1805 This Indenture with the receipt thereon endorsed was acknowledged by Byrd Barrer party sheweth and *James D.* to be recorded.

This Indenture made this 1st day of August A.D. one Thousand eight hundred and five between Ellis Gray Blake and Mary his wife and Robert Goodwyn of the one part, and Peter Blon of the other part all of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Witnesseth That ~~for~~ and in consideration of five hundred Dollars in hand to him the said Blake paid, the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge, he the said Blake hath bargained, sold, aliened and conveyed and doth by these presents bargain, sell, alien and convey unto the said Peter Blon, and his heirs and assigns certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying and being situated in the aforesaid County and to be bounded as follows. Beginning at the Corner of B. W. Johnsons line on the South side of the road leading from Bittichens to Bee-field running up the different courses of said Road to the good branch (where it crosses the road) Thence up the said branch the various courses to John Wrights line, Thence along Wrights and Sannels lines various courses to Surrey Plot, to the Corner of Benjamin Barkhams, Sannels and B. W. Johnsons Land in a small bottom at the Road, thence a straight course to the beginning containing one hundred and forty four Acres and more or less, to have and to hold to him the said Peter Blon and his heirs, & the said Blake and Mary Blake as hereby sent in all claims, right and title for themselves, their heirs, Executors and administrators, forever in and upon the Premises and Robert Goodwyn for himself, his heirs, Executors and administrators doth hereby relinquish all ~~claim~~ right and title in and upon the aforesaid one hundred and forty and four tenths acres of Land, and further more the said Ellis Gray Blake and Mary Blake hath this day and doth by these presents bargain, sell, alien and convey unto him the said Peter Blon and his heirs forever all their claims, right and title reversing in and upon the Land set apart
