This Indenture made this 25th day of October in the year
 our Lord Christ, one Thousand eight Hundred and five, Between
 Francis Clements and Rebecca his Wife of the County of Leon
 and State of Virginia of the one part, and Josiah Vick of the same
 County and State aforesaid of the other parts Witnesses etc. That the said
 Francis Clements and Rebecca his wife for and in consideration of the
 sum of Six hundred pounds Current money of the said State of
 Virginia, to them in Hand paid by the said Josiah Vick at
 and before the signing sealing and delivery of this present, the receipt
 of which said sum the said Clements and Rebecca his wife doth hereby
 acknowledge, and themselves therewith fully satisfied Contented and
 paid, hath bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and Confirmed, and by these
 Presents doth hereby bargain, sell, alien, convey, and forever Confirm unto
 the said Josiah Vick his heirs and assigns, two certain Tracts of Land
 or parcels of land, lying and being Situated in the County of Hampton
 and Parish of Nottingham, on the West sides of Nottingham River,
 adjoining the Land of Henry Briggs, the Land belonging to the
 estate of Charles Spivey Deceased, and the Land of the said Josiah
 Vick that he purchased of Kirby Vick, and are bounded as follows
 (First) Beginning at the mouth of Nottingham Swamp where it
 empties into the River, thence up the Course of the said Swamp
 bounding on the said Henry Briggs line to a line of marked trees
 there along that line, which is now the dividing of this tract and
 of the other tract, hereby bargained and sold as aforesaid (but which
 line formerly was the dividing line of Josiah Vick and James Butler
 of whom the said Butler purchased this said tract of Land) to Nottingham River
 thence down the various Courses of the River to the Beginning - Contain-
 ing four hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less, and is the
 same tract of Land that hath been in Butler family for a number of
 years and sold by the said James Butler as well as the other tract hereinafter
 and bounded, unto the said Francis Clements as well as said fully appear-
 appeared being had to his and his wife Sally, and of bargain and sale
 to the said Clements, bearing date on the twenty fifth day of April, in
 the year of one Thousand eight Hundred and two, and is duly Recorded
 in the said County Court of Hampton. The other tract is bounded as follows
