This Indenture made this Twenty fifth day of
February in the year of Christ One thousand eight hundred and
five between Francis Harris of the County of Southampton of
the one part and Aaron Norfolk of the same County of the other
part Witnesseth that the said Francis Harris for and in
consideration of the sum of Fifty nine pounds Eleven shillings and
three pence current money to him in hand paid by the said Aaron
Norfolk the receipt whereof the said Francis Harris doth hereby
acknowledge, hath granted bargained and sold, aliened enfeoffed
and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell
alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Aaron Norfolk his heirs
and assigns for ever one certain tract or parcel of land lying on the
south side of the Flat Swamp in the County of Southampton aforesaid
and containing by a late survey one hundred and thirty one and one quarter
acres, more or less, being the said Francis Harris dividend of the land
of which his father Hardy Harris died Seised as will appear by a platte
of the survey aforesaid and the Report of the Commissioners appointed by the
Court of Southampton to make distribution of the land of the said Hardy Harris
between the different distributives, reference being thereto had, also the reason
and reasons, remainder and remainors, Rents, issues and Services thereof and
all the estate, right, title, interest, property, Claims and demands whatsoever
of him the said Francis Harris in and to the said tract or parcel
of Land and premises, with its appurtenances and every part thereof
to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and premises
abovesmentioned with its appurtenances unto the said Aaron Norfolk his
heirs and assigns forever and the said Francis Harris for himself and
his heirs, the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises, and
every part thereof against him, his heirs and against the Claims and
demands of all and every other person and persons whatsoever to the said
Aaron Norfolk his heirs and assigns shall and will remain by
