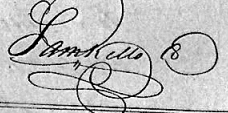

This Indenture was made this 18th day of December in the year of our Lord 1805, Between Edmund Wood and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Long of the one part and Thomas Gray of the County of Hampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said Edmund Wood and Elizabeth his wife for and consideration of the sum of one Thousand dollars unto them in hand paid by the said Thomas Gray, the receipt whereof the said Edmund Wood hereby acknowledges and himself fully satisfied and paid one of the said debts by these presents request the said Thomas Gray they the said Edmund Wood and Elizabeth his wife hath granted, bargained, and sold, aliened, conveyed, confirmed, and by these presents doeth grant, bargain, and sell, alien, convey and confirm unto the said Thomas Gray all the Land of which Joshua Wood died Seignior, vizt ~~Wifes~~ by and being situated in the County of Hampton and lately in the possession and occupancy of ~~Shadrach~~ = Wood etc.
