This Indenture made this 26th day of November
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five, Between said
Jacob Brite and Mary his wife of the County of Southampton and the
County of Hampshire of the one part and Nathaniel Brite Son of the County
of Hampshire of the other part Witnesseth that the sd
said Jacob Brite and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum
of three hundred and twenty dollars to him in hand paid by the sd
Nathaniel Brite before the sealing and delivery of these presents the
Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to be fully paid and
paid hath granted bargained and sold and doth by these presents grant
bargain and sell unto the said Nathaniel Brite a tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County of aforesaid situate in the town and
p^r of Southampton containing by estimation twenty four acres be
the same more or less and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning
at a pine a corner tree of John Harts and Nathaniel Brite line to
a pine thence along the said Harts line to a Hickory in the
County line thence along the said County line to a pine in the said
County line thence along to a black oak a corner tree of Nathan
Brite line thence along the said Brite line to the beginning at the
part of a patent granted to Jacob Brite to hold the said land
and Premises thence or thence with the appurtenances unto the sd
Nathaniel Brite Son his heirs and assigns forever; and also the common
or commons, remainder and remainders, rents and Services of all and
Singular, the said Premises and also all the right title Interest property
Claim and Demand of them the said Jacob Brite and Mary his wife
for themselves their heirs Executors &c with Covenant grant and agree to and
with the said Nathaniel Brite that the said Nathaniel Brite Son
his heirs Executors &c shall and lawfully may have henceforth
hereafter quietly and peaceably have full possession right and enjoyment
of the said Land and Premises above mentioned and sufficiently and
effectually him and heirs and assigns to incumber whatsoever
