This Indenture made this 14th day of October in the year of our Lord Christ 1805: Between Thomas Camp and Patsy his wife of St.ampton County and State of Virginia of the one part and Benjamin Weston of the same County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Thomas Camp and Patsy his wife for and in consideration of the just and full sum of four hundred Dollars current money of Virginia by the said Benjamin Weston to them in hand paid at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Thomas Camp and Patsy his wife both fully acknowledge and through account and discharge the said Benjamin Weston his heirs and assigns forever and doth hereby acknowledge themselves thereunto to be fully and entirely satisfied Contented and paid they the said Thomas Camp and Patsy his wife have granted bargained sold set over and delivered, should and lawfully released and confirmed and by these presents grant bargained sell set over and deliver unto the said Benjamin Weston his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land Situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of St.ampton and Parish of St. Andrew containing
