This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of
October in the year of Lord one thousand eight hundred and five Between
Samuel Rowe and Peggy his wife of the County of Southampton and parish
of Mottonway of the one part and Drury Williams of the same County
and parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuel Rowe
and Peggy his wife for and in consideration of the joint and full sum
of one hundred and sixty three dollars and thirty three Cents & them in
hand paid by the said Drury Williams upon the executing and
delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Samuel Rowe and
wife well truly acknowledge and shew acquit and discharge the
Drury Williams his heirs and assigns forever, and themselves there with they
are entering into and confirmed and paid the said Samuel Rowe and
Peggy his wife have granted bargained sold conveyed released
demised let over Delivered and Confirmed and by these presents doth grant
