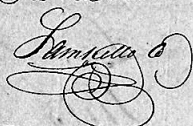

This Indenture made this 30th day of September 1805 Between Elias Plesger and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Northampton and State of North Carolina of the one part and John Plesger Senr of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Elias Plesger and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fourteen pounds eight shillings Virginia Law to them in hand paid by the said John Plesger Senr the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge Have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell
