This Indenture made this 18th
day of November in the year of our Lord 1805 Between John
Beal of Southampton County of the one part and Charles Bryant
of the aforesaid County of the other part, Witnesseth that
the said John Beal for and in consideration of the Sum of
Four Hundred and fifteen Dollars to him in hand paid by the
said Charles Bryant the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
the said John Beal hath granted bargained and sold
aliened enfeoffed and by these presents with grant bargained
and sold alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Charles
Bryant all that Tract of Land which the said John
Beal is entitled by the death of his father lying in Little
County on the North side of Northway swamp the bounds
at presents unknown for the purpose of a legal division
and also all the woods under wood Commons Common of Pasture
profits Commodities advantages Emoluments and Recediments
whatsoever to the said Tract of Land above mentioned belonging
in any way appurtenant or in or upon the same growing happening
or arising and also the revenues and revenues remainders and remainders
rents and Issues and profits and also all the estate right title
Interest Claim and demand whatsoever of him the said John
Beal or in and to the said Premises and any part and
parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the Charles Bryant
