This Indenture made this 16th day of Decr
in the year of our Lord 1805 Between Alldredge Jones and Mary
his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one
part, and John Delidger Senior of the same County and State of
the other part Witnesseth that the said Alldredge Jones and
Mary his wife for and in consideration of the just and full Sum
of Forty dollars by the said John Delidger to them in hand paid
before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
they do hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge
the said John Delidger and his heirs and assigns forever, and
themselves their heirs and assigns fully and entirely satisfied contented and
paid, they the said Alldredge Jones and Mary his wife have
granted bargained sold aliened conveyed, released set down
recorded and confirmed, and by these presents do grant bargain sell
alien convey release set down deliver and confirm unto the said
John Delidger and to his heirs and assigns forever all tracts and
parcels of land containing by Estimation two hundred acres or the same
more or less situated lying and being in the County of Southampton of the
ancient bounds as follows (Viz) Beginning at a black gum in the
Mill necks branch, thence South E. N. 14 poles to a red oak on
the side of a road, thence along the said road, the Vander Busch
gum to a small red oak a corner, thence N. E. E. 34 poles to a black
oak, of the main run of the said swamp, thence along across the Vander
Busch swamp to the beginning
