Wincham This Indenture made this 10th day of August
to West 1805 Between John Windham of Southampton County
Co. & C. of the one part and James West of the said County of the other
part, W^t altho' that for and in consideration of the sum
of Six dollars and sixty seven cents to him or his hands paid by the said
James West the receipt whereof I do Acknowledge doth great
bargain and sale enforff and confime and by these presents doth
grant bargain and sell unto the said James West the certain tract
or paral of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton
the West side of said Windham plantation in the fork of two
small branches, and bounded as follows (viz.) Beginning at a
Cypress pine in the fork of said branches thence up the East prong
of the branch to a Turkey oak in the head of said prong
then along of run marked trees to a common red oak in long
West line. Then Mean and even course along said West line to
the east then to a cedar pine, then to a common pine in the
West prong to said branch. Then down the branch to the original
corner from two acres to the same more or less it being apart of
said Windham land and also all trees wood and underwood
Common and Common of Pasture profits commodities both
in Embankments and Revetments whatsoever to the said tract
or paral of Land above mentioned belonging or any interest
taining or in or upon the same growing thereupon, timber
and also the usual and necessary running and remaining
