

This Indenture made this 1st day of October
 in the year of our Lord 1800- between Drury William
 and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton and
 State of Virginia of the one part, and Shadrack Cobb of
 the same place of the other part - Witnesseth, That
 The said Drury William for and in Consideration of the just
 and full sum of one hundred and thirty dollars Current
 money to him in hand paid or secured to be paid by
 the said Shadrack Cobb at or before the sealing and delivery
 of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby admitted and the said
 Shadrack Cobb thereof acquit to mentionate and discharged, has granted
 bargained sold aliened, conveyed, conveyed and confirmed, and by these
 presents does grant, bargain, sell aliened, convey and Confirm unto
 the said Shadrack Cobb all that piece of parcel or tract of land
 Situate, lying and being in Southampton County and described by &
 Contained in the following boundaries (to wit) Beginning at a black
 gum in the West prong of the Cypress Swamp (some times called
 the long bridge, Swamp, at the mouth of a small branch
 thence up the run of a small, then up the run of the said
 branch to a fork, thence up the western prong or fork, of the 3^d
 branch to a second fork; thence up the left hand prong or fork
 of the said branch to a black gum from thence up the said left
 hand to a short gum, standing in Arthur Densons land, (the short
 gum herein mentioned is a corner tree between said Land of Arthur
 Denson and Shadrack Cobb) thence along said Densons line to a
 Spanish oak a marked corner tree between the lands of Arthur
 Denson and Abraham Densons, thence on the said Densons line
 to a light moss Swamp a corner post between the Land hereby
 conveyed and Jordans Densons, thence on said Densons line running
 and binding to a short gum standing near the run of the said
 Cypress Swamp (the wire in the long bridge Swamp) thence down
 the run of the said Swamp to the Beginning containing thirty
 and a half acres of land parcels of
